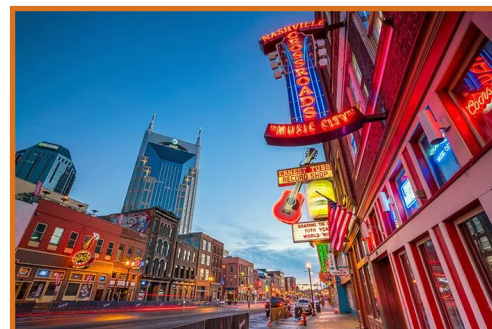


Things to do in NASHVILLE



BROADWAY IS THE BEATING HEART OF DOWNTOWN NASHVILLE!

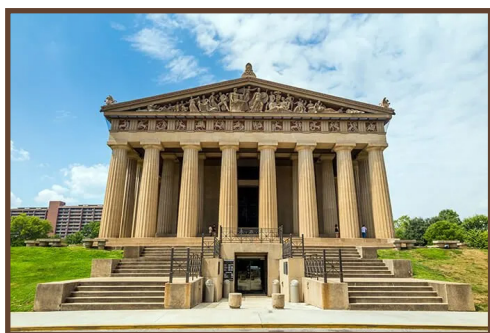

WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE

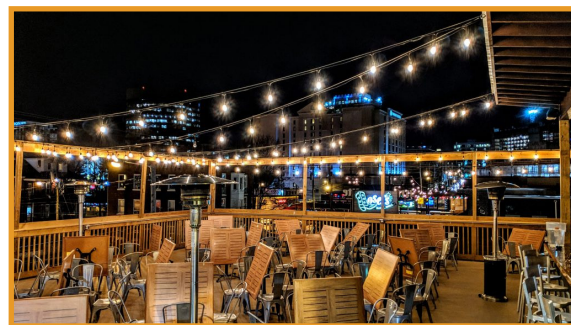
The Parthenon

Before it became known for country music, Nashville was referred to as "the Athens of the South." In 1897, builders decided to run with that nickname and raise a full-scale replica of the Parthenon right in the middle of Nashville. Today, the Parthenon functions as an art museum, park, and cultural center.



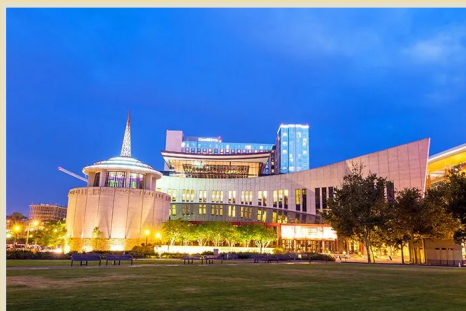
The Local's Broadway - one block away from the Graduate!

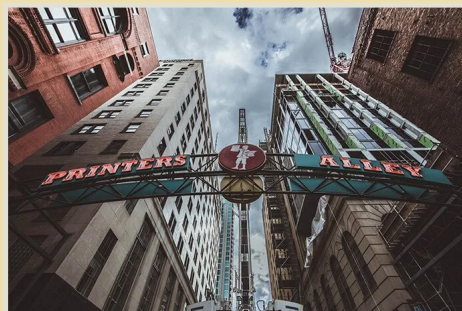
